About - Our acting classes for Preschool - 2nd grade are designed for ages 4-8 with drama games, storytelling, improvisation skills, and more. Children will learn skills to help them on stage and in everyday life – self-expression, team-work, listening and responding, expressing emotions, reading skills, and self-confidence. A great way to channel the imaginations of those in this age group and begin their theatre education!

3rd Grade - Adults: Our acting classes offer the opportunity to learn stage acting techniques through activities and performance. Unlike other programs, class size is limited to enable each student the greatest experience and individualized attention.

Schedule - Fall 2022: September 17th - November 19th, 2022

Winter 2023: January 14th - March 18th, 2023

Spring 2023: April 15th - June 17th, 2023

Summer 2023: August 7th - August 11th, 2023 - Monday - Friday

Preschool - 2nd Grade - Saturdays from 9:30 to 10:00am, during Fall, Winter, and Spring

3rd Grade to 8th Grade - Saturdays from 10:00 to 11:00am, during Fall, Winter, and Spring

High School and Adults - Saturdays from 11:00am to 12:00pm, during Fall, Winter, and Spring

Tuition - Preschool - 2nd Grades: \$110 per 10-week semester, 30 minute classes

3rd Grades - Adult Classes: \$200 per 10-week semester, 60 minute classes

Missed Classes - A student who does not attend a class will simply miss the benefit of that lesson.

Tuition is based on enrollment, reserving your spot in the class, whether classes are attended or not.

There are no credits, refunds, or deductions for missed classes by the student.

Refund Policy - Full refund if canceled at least 48 hours before the first class begins

75% refund if canceled after the first class

50% refund if canceled after the second class

No refund if canceled after the third class or later

Inclement Weather - In the case of inclement weather, it is up to your discretion whether to attend class or not. In extreme cases where we feel it is unsafe to hold class, we will contact you via phone/email at least 2 hours before class begins and move class online for the day. Please check before leaving the house.

Performance - We will have a performance at the end of the semester, either in person or prerecorded. For the performance, students/parents may be asked to purchase costumes and/or props for the performance, totaling \$20 or less. More details will be given during class.

Next Steps - Acting can be taken for multiple sessions, with different topics and scenes each semester. Students can also move onto private acting lessons or musical theatre classes.
